INDICATIONS: Advanced maternal age, Measuring small for gestational age

RESULTS:

• There is a singleton male fetus presenting in a back-down transverse lie with the fetal head to the maternal right side, with active fetal cardiac, limb and breathing movements.

- The fetal measurements are consistent with the LMP-based gestational age of 34 and 0/7 weeks.
- No identifiable fetal abnormalities were seen.
- The placenta is positioned as a complete placenta previa, wrapping from mid anterior position, down across the cervix, and up the posterior wall of the uterus about 4 cm.
- Amniotic fluid volume is normal. There is a 3-vessel cord.
- There is no identifiable cervical dilatation or effacement of the cervix, as viewed with transabdominal scanning.
