Evaluate a Patient in Labor

Marie Manikin is a 24 year old primigravida at 39 4/7 weeks gestational age. She arrived in L&D today at 0300 with SROM and contractions. On admission, her cervix was 3 cm/50%/-1. She was rechecked at 0700 and found to be 5/C/0 station. She received an epidural at that time. It is now 1100 and she is asking for a redose of her epidural.

Go in and introduce yourself to Marie, review her intrapartum records, examine her, and write a progress note, documenting your findings and recommendations, if any.
